		the SIU to compare apples with apples), the SIU has decided to continue working
		off the old tariffs, as set out in the ToR, and the bidders must ensure that they
		prepare their bid submissions based on a percentage increase to such old tariffs.
		Bidders must not use the newer tariffs as set out in the updated Uniform Rules of
		Court.
