HAVING READ THE PAPERS AND HEARD Counsel for the parties it is ordered that:

1. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to respond to the plaintiff's list of admissions and to particularise the full reasons underlying any refusal on the part of the first defendant to make any of the requested admissions.
2. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to furnish his responses to:
 - 2.1 the plaintiff's enquiries in terms of Rule 37(4)(b); and
 - 2.2 the plaintiff's supplementary enquiries in terms of Rule 37(4)(b).
3. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to launch any application proposed by the first defendant for a separation of issues.
4. The first defendant is directed by 30 May 2021 to supplement the plaintiff's core bundle with any documents which the first defendant proposes to rely upon and which are not already included therein.
5. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to identify the issues which, according to the first defendant, arise from the pleadings.




6. The first defendant is directed to revert by no later than 30 May 2021 as to whether the first defendant proposes to effect any amendments to his pleadings and if so, by such date to furnish the plaintiff with a copy of the first defendant's proposed notice to amendment.
7. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to undertake the further discovery of any documents.
8. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to respond to the plaintiff's Rule 35(3) notice.
9. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to launch any *in limine* or interlocutory application proposed by the first defendant.
10. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to provide the plaintiff with particulars of all witnesses who the first defendant proposes to call to testify on his behalf at the hearing of the trial.
11. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to comply with the requirements of Rule 36(9)(b) in respect of the expert witnesses who the first defendant proposes to call to testify on his behalf at the hearing of the conference.
12. The first defendant is directed to require the expert witnesses who the first defendant proposes to call to testify on his behalf at the hearing of the trial to

prepare joint minutes by no later than 15 June 2021 with their respective counterparts reflecting, inter alia, the matters in respect whereof:

- 12.1 there is consensus between them;
 - 12.2 they disagree and setting out the full reasons underlying any such disagreement.
13. The first defendant is directed by no later than 30 May 2021 to indicate whether the first defendant will require any interpreting services at the hearing of the trial.
14. The first defendant is directed to revert by no later than 30 May 2021 as to whether the first defendant proposes to utilise and/or rely upon any photographs and/or video recordings at the hearing of the trial and if so, to furnish the plaintiff with colour copies of all such photographs and/or video recordings by no later than 15 June 2021.
15. The attendance at the conference by counsel was necessary and the costs of senior and junior counsel for preparing for and attending the conference are to be costs in the cause.
