**CASAMBO EXCLUSIVE GUEST LODGE LINKED TO ESKOM WATER TRANSPORT CORRUPTION
IS AUCTIONED TO RECOVER MONEY ESKOM LOST**

Casambo Exclusive Guest Lodge in Mpumalanga will be auctioned in an online timed auction from Tuesday 26 March 2024 from 10h00 to Thursday 28 March 2024 at 12h00. The sale of the property comes after the Special Investigating Unit (SIU) and the Asset Forfeiture Unit (AFU) of the National Prosecuting Authority received an unopposed forfeiture order from the High Court of South Africa: Gauteng Division, Pretoria.

The forfeiture order dated, 20 March 2024, is concerning the corruption at Eskom's Kusile Power Station at the Pretoria High Court.

The forfeiture order also includes a commercial property in Mbombela, a house in an estate, five cars, a golf cart, and a quad bike, which are the proceeds of unlawful activities at Eskom's Kusile Power Station following allegations of serious maladministration and corruption.

Assets forfeited are:

1. Two portions of Casambo Exclusive Guest Lodge in Mbombela,
2. A house in Stonehenge Ext 1 Mbombela, registered in the name of Muzi Sambo,
3. A house in White River Mbombela, registered under Casambo property development
4. Lotus Europa vehicle
5. Subaru Impreza, registered in the name of Zenzile Sanderson

The forfeiture order is part of implementing SIU's investigation outcomes and consequence management to recover cash and assets lost by State institutions due to alleged corruption or negligence.

The SIU is empowered to institute civil action in the High Court or a Special Tribunal in its name, to correct any wrongdoing uncovered during its investigations caused by acts of corruption, fraud, or maladministration. In line with the Special Investigating Units and Special Tribunals Act 74 of 1996, the SIU refers any evidence pointing to criminal conduct to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for further action.

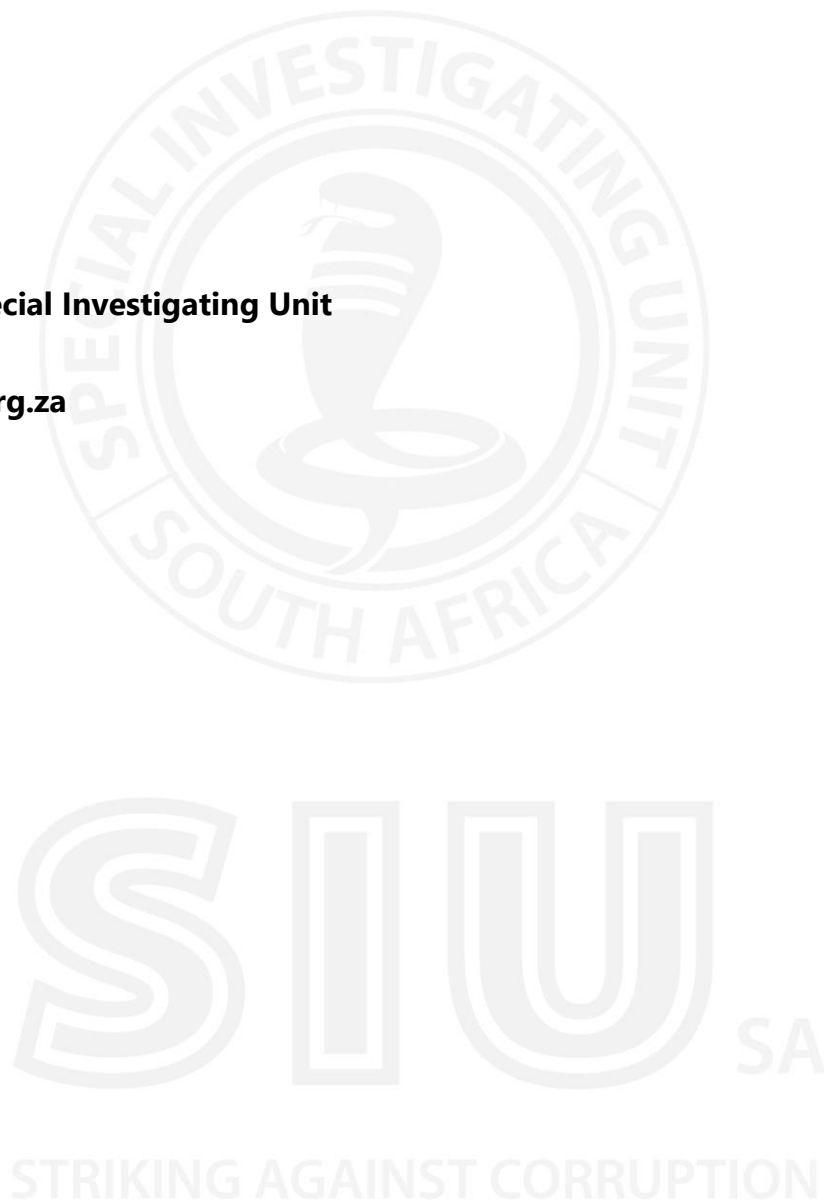
