
## ORDER

---

It is ordered that:

1. The decision of the Department of Social Development to award the Request for Quotation under order number A0749186 to the First Respondent, is reviewed and set aside.
2. The appointment of the First Respondent by the Second Respondent under order number A0749186 is declared to be invalid and set aside.
3. The First Respondent is directed to submit a full debatement of account of the payments received under the contract and all the costs incurred in order to meet their obligations in respect of the contract, supported by the necessary vouchers within 30 days of the date of this order.
4. In the event of the Applicant disputing the debatement of account by the First Respondent, it shall be entitled to subject the debatement of account to an audit by its auditors within 60 days of receipt of the First Respondent's debatement of account.
5. The First Respondent to make payment to the Applicant of whatever profits earned by the Second Respondent upon debate of the account.

6. In the event that a dispute arises between the parties regarding the implementation of this order, the parties may approach the Tribunal for an appropriate order.
  
7. In the event that costs are not agreed: -
  - 7.1 the Applicant shall serve a Notice of Taxation on the First Respondent; and
  
  - 7.2 the Applicant shall allow the Second Respondent to make payment within 7 (seven) days of being served with the taxed costs.
