## ORDER

**HAVING** perused the documents filed of record and having considered the matter, the following order is made:

- That pending the finalisation of Part B:
  - 1.1 The first respondent (Mr Selaelo Phillimon Selota), be interdicted and restrained from selling, disposing, leasing, encumbering (including by granting rights of retention), transferring, donating, disposing or entering into the sale agreement, or dealing in any manner whatsoever with the motor vehicle described as a Mercedes-Benz C200 Avantgarde, with engine number 27492030345081, Chassis number WDD2050422R065406, vehicle register number VVX686W with licence number DT 73 BD GP to any other person or entity, pending the finalisation of Part B.
  - 1.2 The first respondent is directed to disclose the whereabouts of the motor vehicle, as described in paragraph 1.1 above, to the SIU (or the SIU's duly

appointed agents) and to point out the motor vehicle immediately on service of this Order;

- 1.3 The first respondent is directed to ensure that the motor vehicle, as described in paragraph 1.1 above, is and remains insured in the amount equivalent to its current replacement value and maintain such insurance pending the finalisation of Part B.
- 2. The relief sought in paragraph 1 shall operate as interim relief with immediate effect pending finalisation of Part B.
- 3. The Respondents may apply for a reconsideration of the order in terms of Tribunal Rule 12(9).

The costs of this application shall be reserved and determined under Part B.
